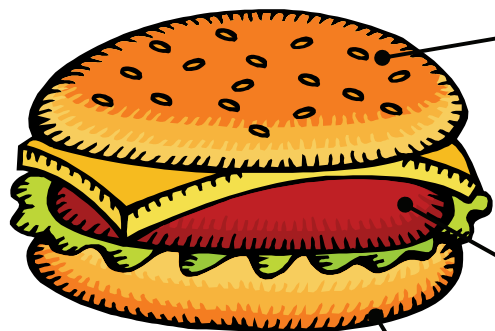

Sequence / order

- at first, to begin with; next, also, then, furthermore; at last, finally, at the end, most importantly
- before, in the meantime, shortly after
